



Membership Subscriptions and Match fees for THC **2023/2024**

Membership Subscriptions (September to March)

NOTE: These age brackets are the age of the member as of the 1st September at the start of the season. This does not change throughout the season if the member turns 18 or 26 during the season, they do not drop down to £8 or up to a £10 match fee during the season.

Senior membership subscriptions

All Seniors (Over 25 from 1st September) will have the choice of paying the Membership subscription:

Either up front in a one-off payment including match fees or pay the Membership subscription on its own and pay match fees each week as they play. Or alternatively in 4 instalments excluding match fees.

Instalment payments (1st instalment before the 31st October) or one-off payments paid before the 31st October

Nonplaying member (social member)

Senior members only: For any non-playing member, a membership fee of £35 will be required in order for them to enter the Club's premises and use the facilities, including the bar. Registration on Teamo will still be a requirement.

18 – 25yrs Membership subscriptions

All 18-25-year-old members will be entitled to a discounted Membership Subscription for the season (see website for details).

The 18-25yr old member will have the choice of paying in 4 instalments.

Or

18 -25yr old Members can pay up front in a one-off payment including match fees or pay the Membership subscription on its own and pay match fees each week as they play.

Instalment payments (1st instalment before the 31st October) or one-off payments paid before the 31st October:

Junior membership subscriptions

The Junior membership subscriptions are split into age categories: see website for details.

Junior membership subscriptions should be paid before the start of the 1st training session in September.

Match fees:

No match fees for under 8's and below

Match fees for Under 12's = £2

Match fees for Under 14's to Under 18's = £5



Under 18 playing Junior Hockey and Senior Hockey

U18's will pay membership according to their age group rate, (Juniors must be 13 to play adult hockey) they will get access to all senior and junior training and senior and junior matches. Pay a match fee for any senior matches and the relevant match fee for their age category if playing juniors.

Any Under 18 who is NOT playing Junior Hockey but is playing Senior Hockey

All under 18's who do not play Junior hockey will pay membership according to their age group rate, (Juniors must be 13 to play adult hockey) in line with the Junior fees and will be charged the appropriate senior match fees.

Subsidised Membership agreements:

This agreement is in place to enable the Club to offer hockey at a discounted rate as long as the recipient is prepared to give back to the Club by way of coaching or any other such voluntary work as the Club deems fit. It is available to the following categories: -

1st year Graduates

All Graduates who are **NEW** to the Club and are in the 1st year out of University are entitled to a subsidised Membership subscription (see website for details) but will still need to pay match fees. They will be expected to 'give back' to the Club by volunteering 5 hours of time to the Club over the season. This will need to be discussed with the section captain and agreed. This is only for the first season; any subsequent seasons Membership Subscriptions will be required to be paid at the normal Club rate for their age.

(if the member decides not to volunteer the relevant membership subscriptions will need to be paid)

Students

Students who are based at St Mary's University will receive a fully subsidised membership subscription providing they can verify their student status by providing a picture of their current Student ID from their university. They will still be required to pay match fees of £8.

Students will be expected to 'give back' to the Club by volunteering 5 hours of time to the Club over the season. This will need to be discussed with your section captain and agreed. If at any point they cease to be a student, they must inform the Club.

(if the member decides not to volunteer the relevant membership subscriptions will need to be paid)

VP's (As appointed by the Club Chairman)

All VP's will need to pay Membership Subscriptions and Match fees.

Back to Hockey

Any player who is coming back to Hockey and is over 35 will receive a subsidised Membership Subscription (to encourage them back to Hockey). All Match fees will be £10 a match.

Hardship and unemployed

Any player who is struggling financially may apply to the Club Finance Controller to seek a subsidy as appropriate. Any subsidy given will be entirely at the discretion of the Club. Any hardship requests will need to be evidenced.



Goal Keepers

Any goalkeeper who has their own kit will pay 50% of their relevant membership subscription:

Any Goalkeeper new to the Club will get their first seasons membership subscription fully subsidised but will still pay match fees.

Borrowing Teddington Hockey Club Goal Keeping Kit:

If members don't have their own kit and would like to borrow the Club's goal keeping kit a £100 deposit will need to be paid before any kit can be taken and an agreement will need to be signed. Each complete set of goalkeeper kit will be numbered and labelled, and all kit will be expected to be returned to receive the deposit back. Ordinary wear and tear will be expected but loss of kit will need to be paid for by the individual who borrowed the kit. To receive the deposit back at the end of the season the kit will need to be checked and signed back in by a designated Club representative.

Goal Keepers who don't have their own kit will pay the normal membership subscriptions and match fees after their first season.
